Bequests

It is a gift within your will that costs nothing now, yet gives you satisfaction knowing you are providing for the future. It is the most common Legacy gift.



Securities/Retirement Funds

You will receive a charitable tax receipt for the full market value of the gift of publicly traded securities. Any capital gain will not be taxed.

If you have no spouse or dependent children to roll your tax deferred investments over when you pass, the total value of those accounts must be reported as income on your terminal tax return. If no arrangements are made, much of your retirement money will go to the CRA. You can eliminate this taxation through retirement plan gifts.



Life Insurance/ RealEstate

You may not need the life insurance policy you purchased years ago. Ensuring your family is looked after, consider a gift of life insurance. You'll receive a charitable tax receipt for the fair market value of the policy.
